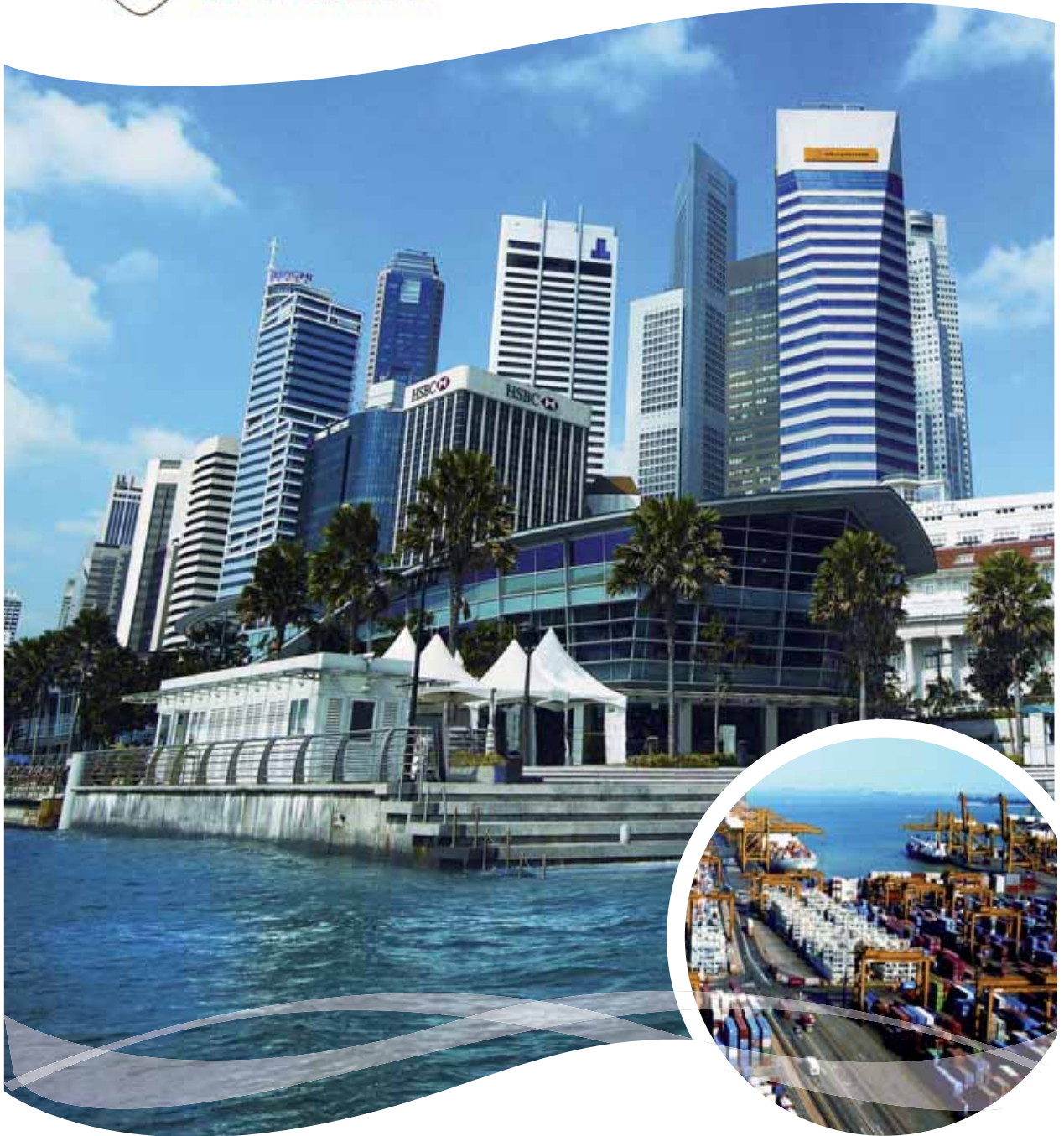

Introduction

The College of Engineering launched the Bachelor of Science (Hons) degree in Maritime Studies in July 2004. The programme focuses primarily on tertiary education in shipping, business, management, and maritime science and technology, to build up the expertise of the local shipping industry as well as working towards establishing Singapore as a centre of excellence for shipping business, research and development. Starting in August 2008, the Bachelor of Science (Hons) degree in Maritime Studies with Business Major is offered jointly by the School of Civil & Environmental Engineering and Nanyang Business School. These programmes are targeted for suitable candidates with GCE A-levels, IB, and diploma holders who have relevant qualifications.

About the programmes

The Bachelor of Science (Hons) degree in Maritime Studies and the Bachelor of Science (Hons) degree in Maritime Studies with Business Major are conducted jointly by NTU and the Norwegian School of Management (BI), Norway. They are also supported by the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA).

Students will complete a semester of their studies at BI, Norway, in their third year of studies. The curriculum also includes an Industrial Immersion - ten weeks for BSc (Maritime Studies) and twelve weeks for BSc (Maritime Studies) with Business Major - where students will be attached to organizations in the shipping and related industry.

Nanyang Technological University (NTU) has been at the forefront of teaching, research and consulting in the areas of business and technology for many years. With the support from the College of Engineering, Nanyang Business School and School of Humanities and Social Sciences, students enrolled in these programmes will learn from academics from various disciplines, thereby developing different skills in a holistic and comprehensive learning environment.



The Norwegian School of Management (BI) is Norway's second largest educational institution, and one of the largest business schools in Europe. BI is the first Norwegian educational and research institution to achieve international accreditation establishing BI as one of Europe's leading business schools.

Why Maritime Studies?

The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) and the shipping industry have recognised that the shipping practice and business in Singapore need to be further elevated in order to enter into the regional and global arenas. A BSc (Maritime Studies) degree is a strategic development that would provide high-level and high-value education for professionals in shipping and related business, elevating them from local business management to one of international business standing. A BSc (Maritime Studies) with Business Major degree shall produce graduates well versed with the maritime industry and strong business knowledge so that they will be the future business leaders in the global maritime industry. MPA and the industry are fully supportive of the Maritime Studies degree programmes. MPA also provides an endowed Professorship (Shipping Management) in NTU.

Curricula

The BSc(Maritime Studies) curriculum aims to provide students with both depth and breadth. The course structure is flexible and broad base. Students will be required to complete:

- Foundation courses including mathematics, social sciences, business and technology.
- Shipping specialist courses including organization and management of shipping companies, international shipping logistics, maritime law, marine insurance, shipping strategy, and a research project.
- Prescribed electives for specialisation in the programme, and General Education Requirement courses for broadening the learning experience.



In addition to the above, the more rigorous BSc (Maritime Studies) with Business Major curriculum includes core business courses in accounting, business law, company law, principles of taxation, business environment, financial analysis & reporting, marketing, and organisation behaviour & design.

The maritime industry is poised to grow 6 to 8% up to 2018. The maritime industry offers good career prospects with commensurate salaries, job stability and job flexibility. Graduates are expected to fill key leadership roles in the maritime industry.

Planner, Post-Fixture Executive, Trade/Pricing Executive, Manager (Voyage Planning), Accounts Manager (Sea Freight), Supply Chain Coordinator, Shipping Executive, Cargo Claims Manager, Export/Import Executive, Brokerage Executive, Analyst (Market Intelligence), and Business Development Manager.

Graduate Studies Opportunities

For those who aim to pursue graduate degrees after their BSc degrees, the College of Engineering offers graduate programmes leading to the award of Master of Science in Maritime Studies, and Master of Science in Logistics. Other business graduate programmes are offered by the Nanyang Business School.

Entry Requirements

In addition to the general admission requirements set by NTU, applicants need the following minimum subject requirements:

GCE 'A' Level: H1/'AO' Level pass in Mathematics or 'O' Level or equivalent pass in Additional Mathematics, and H2/'A' Level pass in Science or Humanity subjects.

International Baccalaureate: Pass in SL Mathematics and a pass in a HL Science subject.

Applicants with relevant diplomas from local polytechnics can also apply to the programme.


