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### **NTU and TUM sign agreement to offer PhD programmes**

Singapore's Nanyang Technological University (NTU) and Germany's Technical University of Munich (TUM) signed an agreement this evening to jointly offer PhD programmes.

The move will establish a broad base of doctoral programmes that aims to generate research, as well as new education and employment opportunities for students.

NTU and TUM will start with a joint PhD programme in Electrical and Electronic Engineering, specifically in Integrated Circuit Design, Micro- and Nano-electronics.

This will be progressively extended to the rest of the programme offerings.

The partnership marks NTU's second joint PhD programme, after it signed an agreement with Imperial College earlier this year.
