

Kelleher is dean of Lee Kong Chian School

DERMOT Kelleher, the incoming principal of the Faculty of Medicine at Imperial College London, has been appointed dean of the Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine. The school was founded in 2010 on a partnership between Imperial and the Nanyang Technological University (NTU). With over 30 years of experience in research, teaching and medical leadership, Prof Kelleher will lead the next phase of the development of the school to train more doctors to meet Singapore's future healthcare demands. Stephen Smith, the founding dean of the Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, will focus on his role as NTU's vice-president of research.
