SINGAPORE: Three hundred youths from local universities, polytechnics and ITE colleges gathered at the Junior World Entrepreneurship Forum to share their views on entrepreneurship in Singapore and what more can be done for youths to get them started.

landscape in Singapore, which was recently announced at the 10th anniversary of the Action Entrepreneurship (ACE).

The event is a lead-up to the World Entrepreneurship Forum, which will be held in Singapore this October.

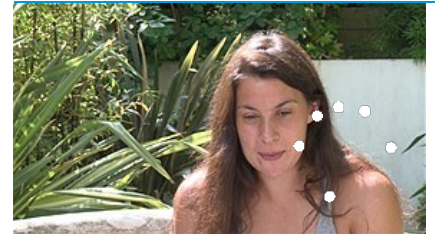
