Three subjects offered at NTU have ranked among the world's top ten according to the 2014 Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings by Subject.

SINGAPORE: Three subjects offered at the Nanyang Technological University (NTU) have ranked among the world's top ten -- a first for the university.

According to the 2014 Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings by Subject, NTU's Communication & Media Studies is ranked 6th in the world, Materials Science at 8th position, and Electrical & Electronic Engineering is ranked 10th.

NTU said the subject Communication & Media Studies jumped an impressive 17 positions within two years since QS started ranking this subject, to become Number 1 in Singapore and in the Asia-Pacific.

Subjects Materials Science and Electrical & Electronic Engineering are also among the star performers with the biggest improvements over the last three years.

At 8th place, Materials Science has vaulted 33 places since 2011, while 10th-placed Electrical & Electronic Engineering has leapt 26 places within the same period.
