SINGAPORE — Korean all-girl band Dal Shabet and MediaCorp stars will be taking the stage for a free concert, to be held as part of the Nanyang Technological

University's (NTU) fiesta on Aug 29.

Dal Shabet will perform some of their most popular songs, including Joker, the title track from their latest EP Joker Is Alive, which has garnered more than 4.4 million views on YouTube since April.

The event, to be held at the Marina Bay Promontory, is open to the public, and will also feature local celebrities such as Rebecca Lim, Elvin Ng, Zhang Zhen Huan, Shane Pow, Jeffrey Xu, Nat Ho, Eswari Gunasagar, Elfaeza Ul Haq, Charlie Goh and Jae Liew.

Hosted by 987FM DJs Gerald Koh and Joakim Gomez, the concert is part of NTU Fest 2015, the university's biggest student-run event marking the start of the new academic year. Now in its second year (the first was held at the Padang and saw more than 8000 visitors), the festival also comprises a day-long carnival with food and games, and a charity run. This year's instalment, though, will be part of NTU's celebration of Singapore's Golden Jubilee.

Launching the festivities is Minister for Education and Chairman of the Singapore50 (SG50) Steering Committee, Heng Swee Keat, who is expected to perform a National Day song with the finalists of Channel 5's reality singing competition show, The Final 1. Other featured acts include local bands ORANGECOVE, The Paragoei and District 12.
