



Nanyang Technological University, Singapore (NTU Singapore) is inviting entries for the inaugural NTU Singapore Global Digital Art Prize.

This biennial international competition is designed to recognise outstanding creativity in art, design and cultural heritage that makes significant use of digital tools in its creation.

To be awarded for the first time in 2019, the Prize will see top winners receive cash prizes of up to S\$25,000 and the opportunity to premiere their works at a major symposium by the NTU Institute of Science and Technology for Humanity (NISTH) in October 2019.

The theme for the first edition of the Prize is "The Fourth Industrial Revolution." It aims to highlight the impact of technological transformation on society and the human condition, as the convergence of the physical, biological, and digital worlds brings about numerous opportunities and challenges. The competition has two categories: Professional (International), and Students (from any Singapore tertiary institution). Each category will award a top prize and commendation awards for excellence, creativity and innovation. The top prize is S\$25,000 for professional artists and S\$10,000 for students.

The winning entries will be chosen by a panel of judges who will represent some of the most distinguished artists and scholars in this field.

Shortlisted and winning artists will have their works exhibited in a special event connected with a major symposium on the same theme "The Fourth Industrial Revolution" that will be hosted by NISTH in October 2019.

All submissions are due by Friday, 15 February 2019.
