Statement on Online Allegations

NTU is committed to upholding the highest standards and international best practices in research, and has zero tolerance towards research misconduct. The University will not hesitate to take action against anyone found to be lacking in research integrity, including imposing sanctions such as expulsion or termination where necessary. In accordance with its research integrity policy, NTU had investigated the allegations by former employee Dr Mohamed Helmy against a number of faculty at NTU. No evidence of research misconduct was found and the investigation outcome had been conveyed to the affected parties.
