Bhubaneswar: As many as eight Memoranda of Understandings (MoUs) were signed between Odisha and Singapore in the presence of President Tharman Shanmugaratnam and CM Mohan Charan Majhi today.

A series of Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) were exchanged between the Government of Odisha and various Singaporean entities to strengthen collaboration in key sectors, as follows:

- Industrial Parks: MoU signed between Odisha Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation (IDCO) and Sembcorp, Singapore.
- Green Hydrogen Corridor: MoU between IDCO and Sembcorp, Singapore.
- Petrochemical and Petroleum Investment Region (PCPIR): MoU between IDCO and Surbana Jurong, Singapore.

- Development of New City: MoU between Bhubaneswar Development Authority (BDA) and Surbana Jurong, Singapore.
- New Energy: Collaboration between Nanyang Technological University (NTU), GRIDCO, and IIT Bhubaneswar.
- Strengthening FinTech Ecosystem: MoU between the Electronics & IT Department, Odisha, and Global Finance & Technology Network (GFTN), Singapore.
- Advancing Skill Landscape: MoU between Skill Development & Technical Education Department, Odisha, and ITE Education Services (ITEES), Singapore, focusing on advanced skilling.
- Skill Development in Semiconductor Sector: MoU Skill Development & Technical Education Department, Odisha, and ITE Education Services (ITEES), Singapore, focusing on and semiconductors.

The President expressed his admiration for Odisha's efforts in advancing skill development and fostering innovation while the Chief Minister presented a memento and shawl to His Excellency as a symbol of the enduring partnership between Odisha and Singapore.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Rashmita Panda, Director, Skill Development & Employment-cum-CEO, WSC, marking the end of a momentous occasion that further deepens the ties between Singapore and India.
