Please note that for all FYP updates and announcements, we will only send them to your NTU students' email accounts. Please check your NTU emails and also the EEE FYP website regularly <http://www.ntu.edu.sg/eee/fyp/default.asp>. Please also take note of the following:

- 1) Please take note that **we will do the project registration for you for FYP after the add/drop period**, so there is NO need for you to do so yourself.
- 2) In case you want to consider delaying your FYP project for one semester, you can do so by the end of Week 2, i.e., by 25 Jan. 2011 (Wed) by emailing me, cc to your FYP supervisor(s). **After 25 Jan. 2011, you cannot drop your FYP project and must complete it for two semesters, i.e., by early Dec. 2012.** This also applies to ABP students even when ABP students drop the ABP status in the middle of doing FYP.
