In recognition of academic excellence and leadership potential, Nanyang Technological University (NTU) has been offering a variety of scholarships to graduate and undergraduate students. Among the many scholarships are: the inaugural Nanyang President's Graduate Scholarship (NPGS) which prepares top graduates or final-year students for global research leadership through doctoral studies; and the prestigious Nanyang Scholarship for bright and talented freshmen from junior colleges and local polytechnics to pursue undergraduate education.

The competitive scholarship scheme was launched in March this year to encourage talented graduates and final year students to take their first step towards a leading research career by pursuing a doctoral degree programme at NTU.

The bond-free scholarship is open to students of all nationalities with first-class honours degrees - or equivalent at the bachelor's level - and a strong passion for research and exceptional leadership qualities. Funding will be provided by NTU for up to four years of PhD studies, covering monthly stipend, tuition fees and other allowances.
