

# Matriculation Details for Higher Degree Students taking Graduate Programmes by Coursework – AY2017/2018 (July/August Intake)

## 1. What is Matriculation?

Matriculation is an important event for you to confirm and register your student status upon arrival in Nanyang Technological University (NTU). It officially places you as a student of NTU. It is **mandatory** before you attend classes in NTU.

## 2. Payment

The bill for tuition fee and miscellaneous fees will be sent to you by the NTU Shared Services (NSS-Finance) approximate 2 weeks after you have registered formally with the University.

## 3. Health Screening

The offer of admission is made to you subjected to the condition that the University is satisfied that you are medically fit to pursue the programme of study. **As such, all students (Part-Time and Full-Time) must undergo and pass a health screening test prior to admission to the University.** Please allow at least 5 working days before matriculation for your medical examination to be processed.

**Notes:**

- i. The above matriculation only includes MOE-subsidised programmes. For matriculation of non-subsidised programmes, candidates should check with the Schools directly on the matriculation schedule.
- ii. Candidates can matriculate on other dates within the above-mentioned matriculation period if they cannot make it on the specified date scheduled for their programme.
- iii. ASEAN graduate scholars and SNA students can register according to their programme of study.

## 5. Documents required during Matriculation

For verification purposes, the **ORIGINAL** of the following documents **MUST** be produced at the time of matriculation:

1. NTU's E-offer letter for admission

**Note:** For candidates who are on conditional offers, you are required to bring your Bachelor degree and final transcript during matriculation. Please **DO NOT** come for matriculation if you have not fulfilled the conditions stated in your offer letter.

2. NRIC/Passport/Citizenship Certificate
3. For non-Singaporeans:

Singapore Permanent Residents: Blue NRIC or valid re-entry permit

Part-time International Candidates: Employment Pass/Work Permit/Dependent Pass (or any valid pass that proves that you are permitted to remain in Singapore during the period of your candidature)

Full-time International Candidates: In-Principle Approval (IPA) letter for Student Pass from Immigration and Checkpoints Authority of Singapore (ICA)

4. Health screening certification from University Health Service
5. Degree scroll(s) and Transcript(s) of Academic Records

**Note<sup>1</sup>:** Applies to graduates of NTU as well. Documents must be in English, otherwise an official English translation must also be produced during matriculation.

**Note<sup>2</sup>:** Candidates whose degree scrolls and transcripts are not ready during matriculation should request from their former university a Letter of Certification stating that they have completed and been awarded the degree.

6. TOEFL or IELTS score report (for graduates of universities with non-English medium of instruction)
7. Deferment of Bond Letter (Former MOE/GLC Scholars)

### **IMPORTANT:**

**MATRICULATION IS NOT COMPLETE IF THE ABOVE ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS ARE NOT PRODUCED FOR VERIFICATION. CANDIDATES WILL NOT RECEIVE THEIR STUDENT NETWORK ACCOUNT UNTIL MATRICULATION IS COMPLETED AND WITHOUT OUTSTANDING DOCUMENTS.**

**CANDIDATES FOUND TO HAVE GIVEN INACCURATE OR FALSE INFORMATION IN THEIR APPLICATION WILL BE REQUIRED TO WITHDRAW FROM THE PROGRAMMES.**

The following is **NOT** applicable to Full-time International Candidates.

**FOR CANDIDATES RESIDING IN SINGAPORE:** If you cannot matriculate personally during the above-mentioned dates, you may authorize a proxy to register on your behalf. The proxy must produce the following **ORIGINALS** during matriculation:

1. Authorisation letter from the candidate
2. Candidate's NRIC/Passport/Citizenship certificate
3. Proxy's NRIC/Passport/Citizenship certificate
4. Originals of the required documents as listed above
