## 4. Documents required during Matriculation

For verification purposes, the **ORIGINAL** of the following documents **MUST** be produced at the time of registration:

- Medical examination must be done at the University Health Service in Nanyang Technological University (NTU). Candidates must present their health screening certification <u>BEFORE</u> they can be matriculated. Please <u>allow at least 5 working days</u> before matriculation for your medical examination to be processed.
- 2. Letter of offer of admission
- 3. NRIC/Passport/Citizenship Certificate
- 4. For non-Singaporeans:

Singapore Permanent Residents: Blue NRIC or valid re-entry permit

Others: Employment Pass/Work Permit/Dependent Pass (or any valid pass that proves that you are permitted to remain in Singapore during the period of your candidature)

- 5. Degree scroll(s)\*
- 6. Transcript(s) of Academic Records\*
- Deferment of Bond Letter (Former MOE/GLC Scholars)
- 8. TOEFL or IELTS score report (for graduates of universities with non-English medium of instruction)
- 9. Other documents submitted in support of your application
  - \* Please note that this applies to graduates of NTU as well. Documents must be in English, otherwise an official English translation must also be provided.

#### Important:

Registration is <u>not</u> complete if the <u>above ORIGINAL</u> documents are <u>not</u> produced for verification. Candidates will <u>not</u> be matriculated students of NTU until registration is completed and <u>without</u> outstanding documents.

Candidates found to have given inaccurate or false information in their application will be required to withdraw from the programmes.

The following is **NOT** applicable to Full-time International Candidates.

FOR CANDIDATES RESIDING IN SINGAPORE: If you cannot register personally on the stipulated date, you may authorize a proxy to register on their behalf. The proxy must produce the <u>ORIGINAL</u> of the following at the time of registration:

- 1. Authorization letter from the candidate
- 2. Candidate's NRIC/Passport/Citizenship certificate
- 3. Proxy's NRIC/Passport/Citizenship certificate
- 4. Originals of the required documents as listed above

Candidates or their proxies will not be allowed to register on other days outside their stipulated date.
