Being a scholar is not a guaranteed success; it just opens the door to more opportunities. It is up to us to grasp the chances and develop our character.

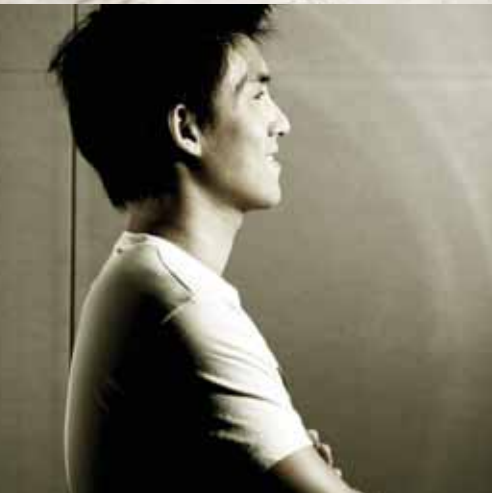

Provisions of the scholarship

If selected as a scholar and upon maintaining satisfactory standard of performance and conduct, you will receive the following throughout the course of your undergraduate study:

- Unique Leadership Training Programme
- Priority for Global Immersion Programme
- Funding for selected overseas exchange programme
- Tuition fees directly payable by students (after Tuition Grant)
- Living allowance of \$6,000 per academic year
- Book allowance of \$500 per academic year
- Settling allowance of \$250 (one-off)
- Computer allowance of \$1,500 (one-off)

Singaporeans enjoy the scholarship bond-free.

The makings of a Nanyang Scholar

To qualify for the Nanyang Scholarship, you must not be on or have received any other scholarship. Excellent grades in the GCE 'A' Level Examination or a certificate of merit for your diploma if you graduated from a polytechnic will stand you in good stead to become a Nanyang Scholar. In addition, your Co Curricular Activity (CCA) record should demonstrate leadership potential throughout your junior college or polytechnic years.

If you obtained your pre-university education overseas, the same high standards of academic and CCA proficiency is also expected.

To apply for the scholarship

As the scholarship is offered to students admitted to NTU, you should first submit the online application form at www.ntu.edu.sg/admissions for admission to NTU. Applications for admission and scholarship will close on the same date.

- Polytechnic applicants - 1st to 21st February each year
- Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'A' Level applicants – 3 days after the release of 'A' level results to 1st April each year

After you have successfully submitted the online application form for admission, the "Application for Scholarship" link will appear. To apply for the scholarship, key in the application number assigned to you, and complete the application for scholarship online. You are required to furnish an online appraisal and one essay of 250 – 300 words. You will be invited for an interview if you are shortlisted.
