

BISHAN-TOA PAYOH GRC COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

What is it?

The scholarships are awarded by the Bishan-Toa Payoh GRC to provide financial assistance to Singaporean children of Bishan-Toa Payoh residents who are pursuing tertiary studies in local universities, polytechnics and the Institute of Education (ITE).

The values* of the scholarships are:

- \$5,500 per annum for bachelor degree programmes
 - \$2,350 per annum for diploma programmes
 - \$1,400 per annum for Nitec and Higher-Nitec programmes in Institute of Technical Education
- *The actual amount disbursed will take into account the amount the scholar receives from the CDC, CCC and GRC Community Scholarships, other sources of scholarships, grants and bursaries. The committee may exercise discretion over the decision and its decision will be final.*

The scholarship will cover the **full normal duration** of studies for those with *at least one year* of studies left.

Is there a bond?

There shall be no bond but the scholars are strongly encouraged to perform voluntary community service in Bishan-Toa Payoh GRC grassroots organisations during their school vacations and after they graduate. All scholars will be required to make a pledge to perform voluntary community service.

Who is eligible?

The scholarships are opened to Singapore citizen students from low income families in Bishan-Toa Payoh GRC who have gained admission or are already pursuing local tertiary studies. While there is no restriction in the courses of study, the scholars must pursue courses supported by the Ministry of Education Tuition Grant Scheme in the local universities, polytechnics and ITE. The courses for the local universities are limited to bachelor courses and do not include Masters or Doctorate courses.

The scholarships are open to students studying full time programmes at the following local institutes of higher learning:

1. All Institutes of Technical Education (ITE)
2. Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP)
3. Republic Polytechnic (RP)
4. Temasek Polytechnic (TP)
5. Singapore Polytechnic (SP)
6. Ngee Ann Polytechnic (NP)
7. LaSalle College of the Arts
8. Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA)
9. National University of Singapore (NUS)
10. Nanyang Technological University (NTU)
11. Singapore Management University (SMU)
12. Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD)
13. Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT)
14. Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS)

The applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Singapore citizen (applicants with at least one parent who is a Singapore citizen may also apply)
- Resident in Bishan-Toa Payoh GRC (when applying and receiving the scholarship)
- Gross Monthly Per Capita Household Income (PCHI) does not exceed \$1,200.00
- Successful applicants must not also hold scholarships from other schools and private organisations
(Successful applicants will need to sign a declaration form prior to receiving the Bishan-Toa Payoh GRC Community Scholarship)

Deadline for application

Application form and supporting documents are to be submitted by **31 Mar 2019**.

Applicants waiting for posting results from universities are welcome to apply but are required to provide

school's acceptance letter if awarded the scholarship.

Application Process

All applicants will be invited to attend a selection interview.

The 7 members' selection panel will consider the applicants' examination results, CCA and participation in community service activities. The selection panel may request grassroots leaders to find out more about the applicants and their families' socio-economic circumstances to verify the information in the application forms.

Applicants must separately seek admission to the institutions when the institutions invite applications for admission and must be accepted for admission or have already been admitted before the final selection.

The decision of the selection panel is final.

Successful Application

The recipient of the Bishan-Toa Payoh GRC Community Scholarship needs to submit full examination results to the Constituency Office before each cheque payment. Recipient needs to **pass all modules in every term** in order to be qualified for the next payment (If applicable).
