News Summary:

Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Singapore have won up to S\$40 million (US\$28 million) in research funds from the National Research Foundation (NRF), Singapore.

This follows NRF's fifth call for proposals under its Competitive Research Programme (CRP) Funding Scheme.

The scheme awards up to S\$10 million for each successful research proposal, over three to five years. The latest CRP call with the theme "Sustainable Urban Systems," saw NTU garnering four awards.
