

CAAS, NTU to start air traffic institute

THE Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) and the Nanyang Technological University (NTU) have signed a memorandum of agreement to establish the Air Traffic Management Research Institute (ATMRI). The outfit will be Singapore's first institute dedicated to research and development in air traffic management. Over the next five years, CAAS will provide \$50 million to fund R&D undertaken by the institute, as well as experts for the research projects, while NTU will provide in-kind contributions of \$22 million, including research manpower and facilities.
