Residential halls at North Hill	
Size	- 6 blocks
Floors	- 13 storey public high rise buildings which include 3 storeys of common facilities (i.e. common study areas, sky lounges, gym)
Expected completion date	- Middle of 2016
Capacity and features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Over 1,850 students - Common study areas and lounges - Sky lounges - NTU's largest gym (approx. 580 sq m) - 1 large multi-purpose hall - Reading rooms - Music/dance rooms - Rooftop BBQ terraces - F&B and shops
Eco features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Around 480 solar-powered energy systems to power lighting at common areas and hot water dispensers. - Motion sensor LED system - Dual refuse system (separate chutes for waste and for recycling) - "Low-E" glazed windows – special coating that reflects heat and UV rays - Specially designed louvres for enhanced ventilation - "Green cement" (reused industrial by-products such as ash, silica and slag) used for i.e. foundation.
Construction method	- "Lego-style" prefabricated pre-finished volumetric construction (PPVC)

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
