



NTU President Subra Suresh to Receive ASME's Most Prestigious Medal for His Achievements in Engineering

Professor Subra Suresh, President of Nanyang Technological University in Singapore (NTU Singapore), has been unanimously selected by the Board of Governors of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) to receive its highest honour, the 2020 ASME Medal.

President Suresh, who is also NTU's inaugural Distinguished University Professor, is recognised for his "pioneering contributions to the science and technology of mechanical engineering through multidisciplinary research, impactful work in education and

mentoring, leadership in academia and government, and innovation in connecting research to industry and policy”, said ASME.

A professional society founded in 1880 and currently comprising more than 100,000 members from over 140 countries, ASME awards this accolade annually to no more than one individual to celebrate eminently distinguished engineering achievements.

Suresh joins a distinguished list of only 87 previous recipients of the ASME Medal since the award was first created in 1920.
