Scientists create safer, sustainable antimicrobials for cow udder infections

Scientists have developed novel antimicrobial compounds that effectively prevent udder infections in dairy cows.

These new compounds, tested in a preliminary farm trial, showed no adverse effects on the cattle or their milk, offering a safer alternative to traditional antibiotics.

The research, led by NTU Singapore and SMART, aims to commercialize these biodegradable and environmentally friendly antimicrobials, addressing significant economic losses in the dairy industry.
