Dear Students

Since the start of Covid-19 pandemic, **virtual interviews** have grown in popularity and are now becoming a new norm. Even as we navigate towards the endemic phase, this interview format is expected to stay.

Employers may choose to continue with this format as an initial candidate screening option. Over the last 2 months, I have received feedback and gained a deeper understanding on how our graduates and students had performed in their virtual interviews and would like to share some tips and tricks:

**Tip #1:** Do not assume that interviewers cannot see what you are doing despite it being a virtual interview.

**Tip #2:** It is often apparent when you are reading off a script from your computer screen. Be prepared by practising your answers before the interview. Mean what you say.

**Tip #3:** First opinion still matters. Dress and groom yourself much like how you would for a physical interview.

**Tip #4:** Interviewer(s) expect you to be ready in a conducive environment with functional camera, microphone and internet connectivity. As various virtual meeting platforms function slightly differently, arrive slightly early to perform technical checks.

**Tip #5:** Even if it may feel a little odd, maintain consistent “eye contact” with interviewer(s) by looking at your camera instead of at the screen.

**Tip #6:** Rehearse, rehearse and rehearse! Practise by recording yourself at your own availability prior to interviews. Review and observe not just your verbal but non-verbal body language to gauge how comfortable you are.

Remember that these tips are not just relevant for virtual but also physical interviews as well. Armed with these tips, I hope you would be more ready to ace your next interview and score that desired position! All the best and good luck.
