In addition, don't forget to prepare for next week's virtual Job-In Fair (30 Aug – 3 Sep 2021) where you can connect with more than 200 employers for potential internship/job opportunities. Before the Fair officially begin, do you know that you can already [register](#) and login to upload your resume, professional photo and create your profile?

Some tips:

- Prepare impactful and targeted resume content based on the role that you are interested in. Remember, *one size DOES NOT fit all!*
- Shortlist the list of companies and roles you are interested in and research on them to prepare good questions to ask during the event.
- Network, network & network; Don't be a window-shopper! Do get inside the company booths to engage and chat with the company reps who have allocated their precious time to speak with all of you.
