


DRESS FOR SUCCESS

- ✗ Polo T-shirts / T-shirts
- ✗ Crop Tops / Spaghetti Tops
- ✗ Sports Attire
- ✗ Leggings / Ripped Jeans
- ✗ Bottoms above the knee - Bermudas, Shorts, Mini skirts, Skorts
- ✗ Clothing with vulgarities or graphics
- ✗ Casual Footwear, e.g., Crocs, Flip Flops, Sandals, Boat Shoes, Sneakers, Slip-on Flats
