

## **Tuition Fees for Graduate (Coursework) Full-Time and Part-Time Programmes for Academic Year 2022-2023**

### **(A) Notes on Fees**

#### **1) Eligibility Guidelines for Ministry of Education (MOE) Subsidy**

The substantial tuition subsidy from the Government of Singapore comes in the form of an MOE Subsidy which is administered by the Ministry of Education (MOE) and is offered to all admitted students in eligible Masters programmes up to the normal programme duration.

##### **(1.1) Students with a Higher Degree Qualification**

Students who have previously enjoyed MOE subsidy or government sponsorship in a graduate programme will not be eligible for MOE subsidy in another graduate programme at the same or lower level. Instead, such students will be liable to pay “Non-subsidised Fees” for the graduate programme that they now wish to undertake. For example, students who had previously enjoyed MOE subsidy in a Masters programme and had attained the Masters degree will not be eligible for subsidy in another programme at Masters degree or lower level. In addition, if they wish to upgrade in another discipline area where the programme has a combination of Masters and PhD candidature, they will not be eligible to enjoy MOE subsidy during the Masters candidature.

##### **(1.2) Transferred or Re-admitted Students**

Students who are transferred or re-admitted within NTU or across Autonomous Universities \*\* may not be eligible for MOE subsidy for the full normal programme duration for the new programme, depending on the number of semesters of MOE subsidy received from the previous programme.

\*\* Autonomous Universities refer to NTU, National University of Singapore (NUS), Singapore Management University (SMU), Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD), Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT) and Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).

#### **2) Service Obligation**

With effect from AY2020-2021, service obligation is no longer applicable to students taking Masters by coursework programmes.

## **(B) Tuition Fees**

All fees listed below are in Singapore dollars (S\$). Every year, fees are reviewed and subject to revision.

### **Notes:**

1. The fee adjustments for the remaining course duration are as follows:
  - Tuition fees for students admitted in AY2020/2021 and AY2021/2022 intakes will be adjusted by \$50 per annum for Singapore Citizen (SC) and Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) students, and \$100 per annum for International Students (IS) for the remaining course duration.
  - Tuition fees for students admitted in AY2022/2023 will be the same throughout the normal course duration as cohort-based fees is introduced from AY2022/2023.
2. For Singapore Citizen and Singapore Permanent Resident under subsidised programmes, the tuition fees are exclusive of GST. The GST for these students is subsidised by Ministry of Education (MOE).
3. For international students under subsidised programmes and students on non-subsidised tuition fees<sup>4</sup>, the tuition fees are inclusive of 7% GST for Semester 1, applicable before 1 Jan 2023; and 8% GST for Semester 2, applicable with effect from 1 Jan 2023. GST on tuition fee is to be borne by students.
4. For Singapore Citizen on non-subsidised fees, GST increase of 1% will be absorbed by the University.
