

CN YANG SCHOLARS PROGRAMME SCHOLARSHIP - Offered in 2025

Terms and Conditions

1 The CN Yang Scholars Programme Scholarship (the "Scholarship") is tenable only at the Nanyang Technological University, hereinafter called "the University".

2 The Scholarship is awarded for you to pursue your undergraduate programme as indicated in your scholarship offer email and is tenable for up to the normal duration of your undergraduate degree programme at NTU. The Scholarship will be retracted/terminated if you change or defer your programme subsequent to your scholarship offer or if you are no longer on the CN Yang Scholars Programme (CNYSP). The value of the Scholarship is as follows:

- Subsidised tuition fee (after MOE Tuition Grant)
- Living allowance of S\$6,500.00 per academic year
- Accommodation allowance of up to S\$2,000 per academic year Applicable to scholars who reside in NTU hostels
- Travel Grant of up to S\$8,000 for an overseas study/attachment programme subject to terms and conditions in the Travel Grant Form
- Computer allowance of S\$2,000.00 (once only)

3 There is no bond attached to the Scholarship, apart from the bond applicable to non-Singaporean students under the MOE Tuition Grant Scheme.

4 You must *NOT* hold concurrently any other scholarships, bursaries or university loans (except for one time award or book prize) during the tenure of the Scholarship without the approval of the University. In the event that the University discovers that you have breached this clause, the University shall have the absolute discretion to terminate the Scholarship contemplated hereunder and in such an event, all sums disbursed to you by the University under this Scholarship shall, if demanded by the University, be repaid by you in full.

5 You are expected to take on the role of a student ambassador, or any other similar role, representing the University to give publicity talks, to receive guests, etc, as and when you are called upon to do so.

6 The continued tenure or renewal of the Scholarship is subject to you:

- (a) consistently maintaining a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.5 (over 5.0) or above. Your academic performance will be monitored on a semester basis.
- (b) demonstrating exemplary conduct throughout the entire duration of the programme; and

(c) fulfilling the terms and conditions set out herein and/or such other terms and conditions as may be advised by the University in writing from time to time.

During the duration of the programme, Office of Admissions has the discretion to send a copy of all scholarship warning letters/emails to parents of international students as and when issued to the scholarship recipient by the office.

7 Unless otherwise approved by the University in writing, the Scholarship sum (save for the Travel Grant) shall be disbursed at the beginning of each Semester (total of 2 disbursements per academic year). The Travel Grant shall be disbursed in such a manner and subject to satisfactory compliance with the terms as specified in the Travel Grant Application Form (The Terms of the Travel Grant are subject to change).

8 The Scholarship may be terminated by the University at any time at the discretion of the Office of Admissions or the respective College Dean and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, where:

- (a) you have failed to meet the renewal criteria, i.e., CGPA of less than 3.5 and have been placed on 2 warnings previously; or
- (b) you have violated any rules, regulations or codes of the University or has been convicted of an offence under Singapore law and as a result, received a disciplinary warning from the Board of Discipline, or has been suspended or expelled from the University; or
- (c) if in the University's opinion, your progress or behaviour has not been satisfactory or there has been any misconduct on your part; or
- (d) you have failed/refused or have indicated that you are unable or do not wish to continue with your programme at the University; or
- (e) you change or defer your programme of study subsequent to your scholarship offer; or
- (f) you are no longer on the CN Yang Scholars Programme; or
- (g) you have breached or failed to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this Acceptance Agreement.

9 In the event that you obtain another scholarship and/or if the Scholarship is terminated for any reason, including but not limited to the grounds set out in Clause 8 above, or as a result of your withdrawal from your programme at the University or withdrawal from the Scholarship prematurely, all sums disbursed to you by the University under this Scholarship shall, if demanded by the University, be repaid by you to the University immediately and in full. You shall also fully indemnify the University for any loss and/or damage it may incur in relation to the Scholarship.

10 For the avoidance of doubt, you shall not have any right or claim as against the University in the event that the Scholarship is terminated in accordance with Clause 8 hereof.

11 You are required to take advantage of the Tuition Grant Scheme (TGS) which is offered by the Singapore Government.

12 No delay on the part of the University in exercising any right, power or privilege under this Acceptance Agreement shall operate as a waiver thereof, nor shall any waiver on the part of the University of any such right, power or privilege, nor any single or partial exercise of any such right, power or privilege, preclude any further exercise thereof of the exercise of any other such right, power or privilege.

13 The University reserves the right to review and amend the terms and conditions herein at any time by written notice. All such changes shall be deemed to be part of the terms and conditions of the Scholarship. These Terms and Conditions and all enclosures hereto contain the entire agreement between the parties and supersede any prior oral or written agreements, commitments, understandings or communication with respect to this subject matter and may only be amended or modified by a supplemental agreement signed by both parties.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The CN Yang Scholars Programme offers the following benefits:
- Guaranteed overseas final year research project (5 to 8 months) with overseas travel allowance (Average per student: \$15,000)
- Priority for overseas exchange (one-off)
- Guaranteed overseas learning trip with subsidy
- Guaranteed four years of stay in NTU halls of residence
- Opportunities for research attachment from Year One onwards
- Opportunities to attend an international conference with subsidy up to S\$2,000
- Opportunities to meet top leading scientists and academics
- Opportunities for PhD study at NTU or Joint PhD with partner university (Minimum CGPA of 4.00 for application of a scholarship from NTU)
- 2. Maintain a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.5. Any scholar whose CGPA falls below 3.5 for the first time will be counselled by the CNYSP Director. A scholar who fails to meet the minimum CGPA after been placed on 2 warnings previously will not be allowed to continue with the CN Yang Scholars Programme.
- 3. Participate actively in most activities organised by the CNYSP office.
- 4. Required to take on the role of student ambassador, or any other similar role, representing the university to give publicity talks, to receive guests, etc., as and when called upon to do so.
- 5. Scholars' CNYSP candidature may be withdrawn at any time if, in the opinion of the University, the scholar's progress or behavior is deemed unsatisfactory.
