IBDP results from IBO

- Grant NTU Singapore direct access to your results at IBO portal before Jan (for Oct/Nov exam) or Jul (for May exam), via your school's IB coordinator. Otherwise, submit your request with a fee to IBO via IBO's Request for results service link.
- Note: Students retaking exam paper(s) must re-grant access.

IB Personal Code

• Provide in your application your 6-character alphanumeric personal code (e.g. 'xyz123') as shown in your results statement/ transcript. (note: case-sensitive)

- **Criminal Records Declaration**
 - Log on to Check Status to perform your declaration latest by 19 March. Note: Compulsory for every applicant.

Mother Tongue (MT)

- Applicable to Singapore Citizen/PR and students from MOE Schools.
- Provide in your application your MT subject & grade and submit your certificate, i.e. where applicable, O Level Higher MT or A Level 'B' syllabus/H1/H2 MT or IBDP Language B/Language A. (e.g. 'Chinese B', 'Higher Tamil', or 'H1 Malay')
- Note: Language ab initio does not meet MT requirement.
- Submit your MOE exemption letter if you were exempted from taking MT.
- Submit your MOE approval letter if you were approved to study a language in place of MT.
- Applicants without MT if admitted (on a provisional basis) will be required to attain MT before graduating from the University.

Programme Prerequisite

- Check the prerequisite for the programme you wish to apply. See also help tool Programme Prerequisite Checker.
- Note: For programmes requiring Mathematics as a prerequisite, both 'Mathematics: analysis & approaches' and 'Mathematics: applications & interpretation' are acceptable.

Application Choice Auto-Inclusion Scheme (Implied Choice)

- Applicants choosing a programme with a second major will also be considered for its corresponding parent programme with no
- e.g. an applicant indicating 1st choice 'maritime studies with a second major in business', 2nd choice 'bioengineering' and no other choices, will automatically be considered for 'maritime studies' as 3rd choice (implied choice). If, however, the applicant prefers 'maritime studies' first and 'bioengineering' last, he/she should explicitly select 'maritime studies' as 2nd choice and 'bioengineering' as 3rd choice.
- Applicants are therefore strongly advised to indicate their choices in the order of their preference.

Admissions Assessment

- See prerequisite for programme-specific admissions requirements/assessment such as interview, test, or portfolio.
- Higher assessment is expected for double degrees, double majors, and programmes with second majors.
- Competition is expected to be keener for popular programmes with smaller intake. As a guide, see Indicative Student Intake.

Supporting Documents

- Submit supporting documents for additional information you have provided/declared in your application.
- For identification, submit NRIC (front & back) for Singapore Citizen/PR, NS IC (front & back) and passport for NSF, or passport for international/foreign applicant.
- For grades, submit school-issued IBDP results statement/official IBDP transcript, and Sec 4/Grade 10 certificate (e.g. O Level/Year 4 IP transcript/IGCSE).
- Where applicable, include your IB School/High School graduation certificate. Where applicable, submit medical record/report for your medical condition/special need.
- Where applicable, submit IO certificate if you are an IO medallist.
- For each upload item, submit a clear JPG/PDF copy of < 5MB upright & in original colour. Do not zip/compress. Select correct file
- to upload as each file can be uploaded only once. Click 'Confirm' after all items are uploaded. Note: Students participating in IBDP re-marking should apply only after receiving re-marking outcome. Application ends 19 March.

NSF Exemption

• Declare in your application and submit your NSF exemption letter if you are exempted from Full-time National Service. (Male Singapore Citizen/PR only)

Aptitude-Based Admissions (ABA)

and 1 appraisal via Check Status.

- Applicants with exceptional talents and/or outstanding achievements may submit an application for ABA with a 500-word essay
- Shortlisted applicants may be interviewed and must submit official relevant supporting documents for verification upon request.
- Adult Learners Scheme (ALS)
 - Applicants who are Singaporean Citizen/PR and ≥ 25 years of age (as at 1 Jul of the admission year) with ≥ 4 years of professional working experience may complete an application for ALS via Check Status.
 - Shortlisted applicants may be invited for an interview.

Scholarships

 Applicants with outstanding academic and co-curricular achievements may submit an application latest by 19 March via Check Status.
