

## Guide to filling in the Application Form for Singapore Citizens/Permanent Residents with International Baccalaureate Diploma

**Important: The form has to be completed in English characters.**

### Type of Application Forms

This application form is applicable only to students offering **International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma by International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO)**. If you are holding other qualifications, please click [here](#) to check on the correct application form that matches your high school qualification.

Please note that it is **MANDATORY** to grant NTU direct access to your official transcripts via International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) to receive the outcome of your application. You are strongly advised to do so before your IB results are released, by submitting the transcript requests through your school's IB coordinators. After the results are released, each request will incur a USD \$17 fee and must be submitted directly to IBO via the ["IBO request for results service"](#) link. It will also result in a longer waiting time to receive the outcome of your application.

You can only submit **one** application in the admission exercise. Check the header of the application form to ensure you are using the correct form. Your application may be void if you apply with a wrong form. If you hold more than one acceptable qualification, decide which qualification you wish to use and indicate when filling in the application that you are holding another qualification.

### After clicking Submit button

You will be able to view your application number on screen. Login with the password you have indicated in the application form to proceed with the application.

You will also receive an acknowledge email with your application number.

1. Applicants interested in the LKCMedicine programme are to note that only those who have selected the programme as a first choice will be considered. Applicants must not have started or completed an undergraduate programme at any university. Applicants who have previously applied may not be considered unless they have shown significant improvements in their academic grades or UCAT results. Applicants are required to complete an additional section "Application for LKCMedicine Programme" at the Application Tracking Page via the Check Status link upon successful submission of this online application form.
2. **Application choice auto-inclusion scheme.** Applicants choosing any programme with a second major will also be considered for its corresponding programme with no second major, in a manner succeeding any of the 1st to 5th choices if selected in the application form, and if they have not been earlier selected as one of the five choices. E.g. an applicant indicated 1st choice Biological Sciences with a second major in Food Science and Technology, 2nd choice mechanical engineering, and no other choices will be considered for Biological Sciences with a second major in Food Science and Technology, mechanical engineering, followed by Biological Sciences. If the applicant wishes to be considered Biological Sciences as a second choice over mechanical engineering, he should therefore indicate Biological Sciences as a second choice.
3. Students who are offered Engineering or Engineering with a Minor in Business programme will be streamed into either Civil, Electrical & Electronic, Mechanical, Environmental or Materials Engineering from the second semester of year 1 of study on the basis of their year 1 first semester university results and competition.
4. Applicants interested in the double degree programmes offered under Engineering & Economics are allowed to choose no more than 2 from the programmes available.
5. Applicants choosing a particular programme with a minor in business will also be considered for its corresponding programme with no minor, and vice versa. E.g. by choosing 'Bioengineering with a Minor in Business', one will also be considered for 'Bioengineering'. Similarly, by choosing 'Bioengineering', one will also be considered for 'Bioengineering with a Minor in Business'. Applicants need not and will not be provided the option to choose both.
6. If you choose Art, Design & Media as one of your choices, please take note of the additional supporting documents that you need to [submit](#).
7. Please note that the Bachelor of Arts/Science and Education degree programmes offered by National Institute of Education (NIE) are teacher training programmes. Successful applicants will be bonded to serve the Singapore Ministry of Education for 4 years.
