# **Useful information for PBAST 5**

#### **Conference Venue and Program**

The conference will be held at the Auditorium of the School of Arts Design and Media, 81 Nanyang Drive, located within the Nanyang Technological University (NTU) campus. The campus is located about 20 km from the city centre, and 40 km from the airport. The campus is well connected by public transport and by taxis.

#### **Presentation details**

Time allotted for talks (including Q&A): Keynote: 60 minutes; Plenary: 40 minutes; Others: 20 minutes. A computer with Windows Vista and Powerpoint 2007 and Acrobat Reader will be available for the presentation. Standard VGA cables for connecting personal laptops will also be available. Overhead slide/transparency projectors will not be available

<u>Posters</u> are expected to have a maximum size corresponding to standard A0 paper (841 mm wide and 1189 mm tall, i.e. portrait orientation). We will provide pins to fasten the posters.

## Transportation to conference venue

<u>Free transportation</u> buses be provided from <u>RELC</u> and <u>Orchard Parade</u> hotels to the conference venue during designated times (see table above). Participants not staying in the above hotels can also avail this facility by being present in one of these locations. Please lookout for our volunteers at the lobby. Participants unable to take the free service can reach the venue through public transport/taxi.

<u>Public transport:</u> You can take the MRT to Boon Lay interchange. From Boon lay interchange you can take Bus 179 (alight at Hall 2), Bus 199 (alight at BLK 41). Tickets can be bought at MRT stations or from the bus captain. Typical travel time from city centre: 1 hour

<u>Taxis</u>: Round the clock taxi services are available. Depending on the time of travel, taxi charges can vary. From the city the estimated fare is S\$ 25-35. Taxis accept credit cards (surcharge to be paid) and Singapore currency. Typical travel time from city centre: 20 minutes

#### **Dress Code**

Casual attire is deemed adequate for the conference.

#### **Social Programs**

The visit to a tourist attraction(s) on 26<sup>th</sup> (Tues) and will involve outdoor activity. Participants are requested to be dressed in casual attire for Tuesday.
