## FYP COMMENCING ACADEMIC YEAR 2022/2023 SEMESTER 1

## Please take note of the following dates and purposes.

8 Aug 2022 (Mon, Sem1Wk1)	FYP starts  Note that though you are supposed to start your FYP on Wk 1, you are advised to start your FYP earlier unofficially (if possible) since we have a much shorter winter holiday (than the summer holiday) during which you are required to work on your FYP full time to get substantial amount of the investigation done.
29 Aug 2022 (Mon, Sem1Wk4)	Submission of Project Plan/Strategy to Supervisor  Students are required to consult their supervisors on the workout of their Final Year Projects and submit their project plans/strategies to their supervisors.
23 Jan 2023 (Mon, Sem2Wk 3)	Submission of Interim Report  Students are required to submit interim reports to NTULearn, their Final Year Project supervisors to state the progress of their projects.
20 Mar 2023 (Mon, Sem2Wk 10)	Students are required to submit a softcopy/hardcopy of the FYP Final Reports (if hardcopy, Ring binding) to NTULearn, their supervisors and extend a copy to their examiners for grading. Students are to approach their supervisors and examiners in 1-2 weeks time for any modifications to be made to their Final Reports. Assessment of report should be based on this version and not on the amended final report.
14 Apr 2023 (Fri, Sem2Wk 13)	Students are required to submit amended FYP final reports to their supervisors and extend a copy to their examiners. This is the final submission and it is the duty of the supervisors to ensure that amendments have been carried out accordingly. No more further modifications to their FYP reports are allowed after this submission.
