

Part Time FYP COMMENCING ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/2021 SEMESTER 1

Please take note of the following dates and purposes.

Part Time FYP extends over 4 semester, for which one is over special semester during vacation. The 4 semesters are as follows:

Semester 1: Aug-Dec 2021 (2021/2022 S1)

Semester 2: Jan-May 2022 (2021/2022 S2)

Semester 3: Special Sem 1+2: Jun-Aug 2022 (Vacation 2021/2022)

Semester 4: Aug-Dec 2022 (2022/2023 S1)

09 Aug 2021 (Mon, Week1, 2021/2022 S1) (1st Semester)	FYP starts Note that though you are supposed to start your FYP on Wk 1, you are advised to start your FYP earlier unofficially (if possible) since we have a much shorter winter holiday (than the summer holiday) during which you are required to work on your FYP full time to get substantial amount of the investigation done.
30 Aug 2021 (Mon, Week4, 2021/2022 S1) (1st Semester)	Submission of Project Plan/Strategy to Supervisor Students are required to consult their supervisors on the workout of their Final Year Projects and submit their project plans/strategies to their supervisors.
20 June 2022 (Mon, Special Term) (3rd Semester)	Submission of Interim Report Students are required to submit interim reports to their Final Year Project supervisors to state the progress of their projects.
17 Oct 2022 (Mon, Week10, 2022/2023 S1) (4th Semester)	Submission of Final Report Students are required to submit a copy of the FYP Final Reports (Ring binding) to their supervisors and extend a copy to their examiners for grading. Please attach a note stating the names of the supervisor and examiner when submitting the reports to the General Office. Students are to approach their supervisors and examiners in 1-2 weeks time for any modifications to be made to their Final Reports. Assessment of report should be based on this version and not on the amended final report.
11 Nov 2022 (Fri, Week13, 2022/2023 S1) (4th Semester)	Submission of Amended Final Report Students are required to submit amended FYP final reports to their supervisors and extend a copy to their examiners. This is the final submission

	and it is the duty of the supervisors to ensure that amendments have been carried out accordingly. No more further modifications to their FYP reports are allowed after this submission.
