Submission of Interim Report

Students are required to submit interim reports to their Final Year Project supervisors to state the progress of their projects.

Submission of Final Report

Students are required to submit a copy of the FYP Final Reports (Ring binding) to their supervisors and extend a copy to their examiners for grading. Please attach a note stating the names of the supervisor and examiner when submitting the reports to the General Office. Students are to approach their supervisors and examiners in 1-2 weeks' time for any modifications to be made to their Final Reports. Assessment of report should be based on this version and not on the amended final report.
